On the reconstruction of Ukraine in Poznań

In cooperation with the Ministry of Development and Technology, the COMMON FUTURE Ukrainian Reconstruction Congress will once again take place in Poznań on 7-8 October. Representatives of governments and the most important Polish, Ukrainian and international institutions responsible for the reconstruction and modernisation of Ukraine in the coming years will meet with business at the MTP Poznań Expo.

The second edition of the COMMON FUTURE Ukrainian Reconstruction Congress will take place on 7-8 October at the premises of the MTP Poznań Expo. The event is organised by the Grupa MTP in cooperation with the Polish-Ukrainian Chamber of Commerce and the Polish Association of Construction Employers. The congress is organised under the patronage of the Ministry of Development and Technology, the Minister of Foreign Affairs and the Chairman of the Council for Cooperation with Ukraine at the Prime Minister's Office, MP Paweł Kowal.

Among its participants will be entrepreneurs from Poland, Ukraine and other countries, representatives of governments, local authorities and national and international institutions supporting development. A year ago, the event attracted more than 1,200 participants who, during 40 debates and panel discussions, discussed the challenges facing Ukraine and its allies supporting it in the fight against the Russian aggressor. The upcoming edition will also include debates, inspiring speeches, access to experts and, above all, an exchange of contacts with Ukrainian business representatives. Representatives from the following sectors are particularly invited to participate: **construction, industry, investment, energy, medical and humanitarian production, transport and logistics, ICT, cyber-security and dual-use technologies.**

Poland a hub for reconstruction

The aim of the congress is to provide entrepreneurs, politicians, bankers, local government officials with a picture of the economy, state and society of Ukraine in the third year of the war and the needs related to the current reconstruction of Ukraine and the country's modernisation plans. Poland, which has become a hub for humanitarian and military aid to Ukraine in the reconstruction process, already plays a crucial role, determined by: geographical proximity; the level of trade turnover, which makes Poland the first trade partner of Ukraine in the free world; knowledge of the realities of Ukraine, where more than 600 Polish companies are active; the growing entrepreneurship of Ukrainians in Poland; the capacity of Polish production, construction and transport companies; more than 460 partnerships of regions, cities and municipalities from both

Programme of this year's edition

The Programme Council is working on the programme, and representatives of ministries and public institutions supporting economic cooperation and the foreign presence of Polish entrepreneurs have been invited to participate in its work and foreign presence of Polish entrepreneurs. The work of the council is overseen by the organiser Grupa MTP together with its substantive partners: Polish-Ukrainian Chamber of Commerce and the Polish Association of Construction Employers. A detailed programme will be available on the congress website. This year's debaters will focus on the prospect of Ukraine's accession to the European Union and the related new support programme 'Ukraine Facility', the question of Ukraine's energy security and Poland's contribution to ensuring it, as well as cooperation at local government level, based on the experience of large Polish cities. In addition to the leading themes, the following will be present: opportunities and threats for the participation of Polish companies in the reconstruction of Ukraine, possibilities of support for Polish investors, including the economic, legal, insurance and guarantee basis or threats on the labour market.

Two days at the MTP Poznań Expo

The event will take place in the Poznan Congress Center complex on the grounds of the Poznan Expo. This modern conference facility belonging to the Grupa MTP with a modern and multifunctional design will be prepared for two thousand participants from Poland and abroad. Its space will be divided into a debate zone, which will be formed by three stages with discussion panels, and a space for professionals, where participants will be able to learn from experts during individual meetings and workshops and lectures. The event's partners will present their offers in the expo zone, with compact stands. The congress centre building is surrounded by a so-called „Green river” with modernly arranged greenery and recreational areas. A multi-storey underground car park will be available for arriving participants, while those travelling by public transport will have a short walk from the nearby Poznań Main Station interchange in the vicinity.

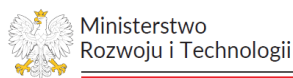
